Our Park Committee along with the County of Forty Mile has seen a need for some form of Regulations by which our Park could reasonably abide with.

A Sub-Committee was formed consisting of Mike Melham, Larry Weatherhead and Bruce Vine. Together some basic elements for the Regulations were set out and were presented to our Park Committee and to the County for their approval and principal.

Our Park Committee and the County reviewed the draft and have approved them in principal.

We, by no means believe these regulations are complete but are a start in the right direction and should be considered as such, and are to take affect immediately.

Initially terms for the November 27<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting will be:

- 2 - 3 year sub-lease holder will be elected to a three year term
- 2 - 2 year sub-lease holder will be elected to a two year term
- 2 - 1 year sub-lease holder will be elected to a one year term
- Two seasonal renter positions will be elected for a one year term;
- One day use (public) person will be voted for by Public; annually for a one (1) year term;

All positions to be filled respectively.

In subsequent Annual General Elections the 3 year term will then be filled by election.

These regulations are new and will probably need further discussion and explanation and can be discussed at the Annual General Meeting, November 27<sup>th</sup> at the Bow Island Legion Hall 7:00 pm.
